

Respiratory precautions

Gloves and apron are no longer needed



1

Hand hygiene

Decontaminate hands before entering the room

2



Personal protective equipment

Staff must wear FFP3 mask and visor when entering the room.

3



Entrance door

Keep the door closed (if unable to do this then document the rationale within the patient notes).

4



Clinical equipment

Clean all equipment after use.

5

Just before leaving

Decontaminate hands
For patient transfers provide patient with a face mask if tolerated. Staff not required to wear PPE

6

After leaving



Dispose of your FFP3 mask and visor in the nearest orange waste bin outside the room, then use hand sanitiser.

7



Environmental cleaning

Chlorine clean. Request an amber (infectious clean) on discharge/transfer.

Visitors:



- Please see the nurse in charge before entering.
- For further information on what personal protective equipment is required please ask the nursing staff.
- Clean your hands before contact with the patient. Clean your hands on removal of the personal protective equipment before you leave the isolation area.
